What does Aflac offer for providers for self-service options?

The Dental Hub is a comprehensive, all-in-one tool designed to streamline tasks for you and your office staff. Through the hub, you can:

- Submit and view claims, predeterminations, and referrals.
- Verify member eligibility.
- View Explanation of Benefits (EOBs).
- Download manuals and documents.
- Sign up for payment options through Optum Bank.

How can I log into the Dental Hub as a first-time user?

To register your office on the Dental Hub as a first-time user, please follow the steps below:

1. Visit <https://app.dentalhub.com/app/login> and click “Log in.”
2. Select “Sign up now” and use your unique email address to create your account.
3. Add Aflac as a payer using the registration code in your welcome letter or by calling customer service at (855) 819-1873. Your tax ID or location address is needed to obtain your registration code via phone.

How do I submit dental claims to Aflac?

There are three ways to submit claims to Aflac Dental & Vision, which can be found on the back of the ID cards:

1. Through the Dental Hub at <https://app.dentalhub.com/app/login>
2. Via a clearinghouse using the payor ID and NEA # located on the member ID card.
With the transition to our new TPA partner, a new payer ID should be leveraged to submit claims: **AFLAC**
